

Advanced Placement Programs at MLA

Students must have adequate test scores and good work ethics to be able to sustain an AP course. AP courses are also at the discretion of counselor and teacher.

AP Studio Art

- MUST have taken two previous art classes OR a written recommendation from Ms. Itayem

AP Computer Science Principles- Intro Survey of Computer Science

- All students are open to take this class if interested.
- Females are needed!

AP Computer Science A- Programming

- Teacher recommendation from Mr. Mirpuri is a must
- Summer work is also a must, if not students will be taken out early on.

AP Calculus AB/BC

- B or higher in pre-calculus
- Pre-calculus teacher recommendation is highly suggested

AP Statistics

- Student must enjoy math. (If student claims to not be good at math the answer is not stats)

AP Spanish Language

- MUST have previously taken 2 years of Spanish
- Recommended for student to have been in a honors Spanish course no matter what country of origin

AP Spanish Literature

- Must have passed AP Spanish Language (grade and test)

AP French/AP Italian

- Students should have taken Italian/French 3 and received an A or B.
- If student has stopped the language for a year, they are not encouraged to continue to AP
- Highly encourage students to take if completed level 3

AP English Literature

- FSA level 4 or 5
- Student has passed AP English Language or ENC 1101/1102

AP English Language

- FSA Level 4 or 5
- Has A or B in English Honors
- GPA above 3.0
- Preferably taken any AP history class

AP Physics

- MUST have already completed Honors Algebra 2 or any other higher math course with a B or higher.
 - *Preferably* taking with Calculus AB

AP Biology

- MUST have a passing 4 or 5 on Bio EOC and A or B as final grade
- Chemistry final grade A or B
- Algebra 1 EOC and FSA ELA passing score or 4 or 5
- Complete all summer work
- Student must be prepared to work extremely hard

AP Environmental

- FSA ELA of 4 or 5
- Passing score of 4 or 5 in Bio EOC
- Grade of A or B in chemistry
- *Preferably* strong math background

AP World/Euro/Human Geo

- FSA ELA score of 4 or 5
- Strong interest in history

AP Psychology

- FSA ELA 4 or 5
- Willingness to work

AP US History/Government

- FSA ELA score of 4 or 5
- Strong interest in history
- Preferably have taken AP classes prior

AP Art History

- Preferable students have taken AP history class
 - AP Euro, AP World, AP Human Geo
